Some of the plastic parts may not stand the test of time which is why Ive fallen short of giving this product a 5star rating. Overall the product is satisfying and is easy to push. Its performance of intended function is pretty spot on. I hope this succinct review helps. The handle is sturdy enough to apply pressure. The cuts are good too. My lawn is about 100sqm in total but as long as you dont let the lawn grow too big, this mower can handle it fairly quick. Pushing it is easy too as long as it gains momentum. I would recommend this mower. However, there are many shortcomings with this product. The collection bucket collects a small amount of grass before it interrupts the rotation blades because the cut grass does not fall back. Therefore, unless you manually keep sweeping the cut weeds out of they way it does not work well. This could be a design defect or flaw. Even for a small garden it cannot handle grass that is over grown or thick grass after rain. You have to make several attempts to go over the same spot for it to cut the thick grass. It seemed to work without the bucket but was a challenge against thick overgrown grass.

So lightweight and easy to use. I had difficulty with starting a petrol mower and now I can mow when I want and how I want. No fuel to buy and I get exercise at the same time. Best buy! I had the delivery arrived within two days, then 15min to setup the mover and then had my lawn moved within 30mins. I have to say, it was so easy. 5 out of 5 for me. The thin blades of grass were just knocked over by the lawnmower blades, not cut. Maybe it would work on a very thick lawn, but I dont know. Good green alternative.
